## University Professor (pay scale W 2) (Academy-Professorship) for Musicology/Digital Music Edition/Digital Humanities

As part of the qualification initiative of the Union of German Academies, this professorship is established jointly by the University of Paderborn and the Academy for Sciences and Literature, Mainz and will contribute to closer networking of both institutions. The successful candidate should be able to demonstrate knowledge of academic musicology with a special focus on digital music editions and/or Digital Humanities in her/his research and teaching activities. One of the duties of the Academy professor will be participation in the work of the Academy project "Beethovens Werkstatt: Genetic Textual Criticism and Digital Music Edition". The candidate is also expected to take an active part in the organisation of the recently established "Center Music – Edition – Media" and in designing a new MA program in the field of Digital Humanities. We are seeking an active participant in interdisciplinary and international research organisations and expect active engagement in obtaining grant funding.

As a corporate institution of the University of Paderborn and the Academy for Music at Detmold, the Institute for Musicology is a leading force in interdisciplinary and interinstitutional development of methods and technologies for digital music editions. In addition to the requirements listed below, please enclose in your application a short (3-5 page) description of your ideas for further development of the research and teaching activities in the Digital Humanities at Detmold/Paderborn.
